- Research-and-development and promotion activities, possibly with funding from the European communities.
- Development of new applications for the products in question.

Functional Barrier Working Group (ABA)



- WG on project basis **in cooperation with the Fraunhofer Institute**
- Founded to respond to concerns about the safety of ABA co-extruded sheets in food contact applications.
- **WG members and structure**
 - Technical experts from Aliplast, Klöckner Pentaplast, MP3 and Coexpan-Montonate
 - Observers from two more member companies
 - coordinated by food contact experts from EuPC.
- **WG objective**
 - Obtaining a standardized, scientifically based protocol which can be used by PSE members to demonstrate the compliance for food contact of their products.
 - Possible development towards a quality trademark.
